
FREEYOU Project

About the training

There is a Moodle platform where the contents and activities are available.

The contents are in 5 different languages and per language the following training sessions:

- 1. Introduction dealing with the term Fake News and its background
- 2. Fact checking who is behind the information, what is the evidence and what do other sources say
- 3. Meme its definition, formats and uses
- 4. Artificial Intelligence Synthetic media: definition, formats and technologies for detecting it

For each session, there is materials, videos, quizzes and exercises available. There is also the opportunity to join the FREEYOU international facilitator community and the discussion forum; a place where it is possible to exchange ideas, tips, and materials.
